STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



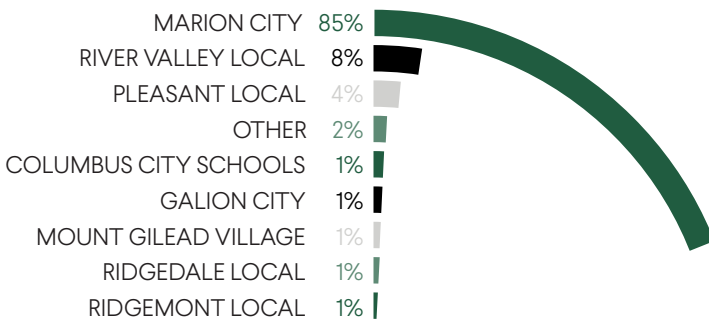

ACADEMIC PROGRESS

In its third year of operation, and first year emerging from the pandemic, Marion Preparatory Academy scored in the Top 20% of charter schools in Ohio. The school met or exceeded state expectations in student growth in every grade level (5 Stars, Progress) and increased its Performance Index (PI) score by over 9%. Additionally, 100% of students met the state reading requirements for promotion to Grade 4. Marion Preparatory Academy additionally met state expectations in closing educational gaps (3 Stars, Gap Closing).
