The school also offers free breakfast, lunch, and afterschool tutoring. Transportation may be provided for students residing within the Marion City School District.

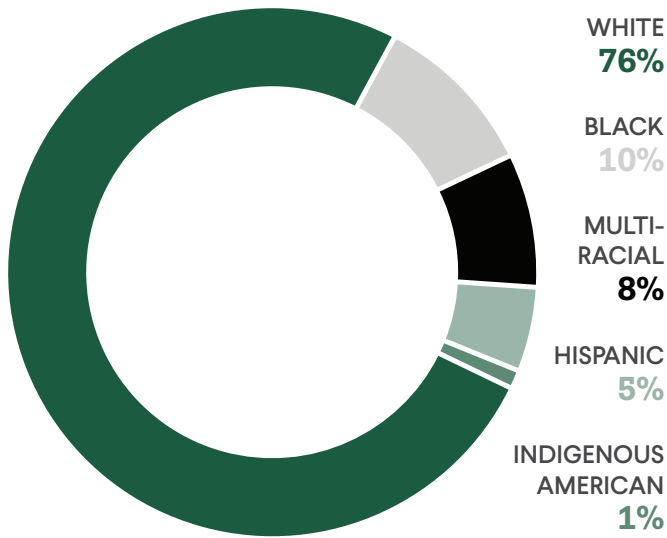

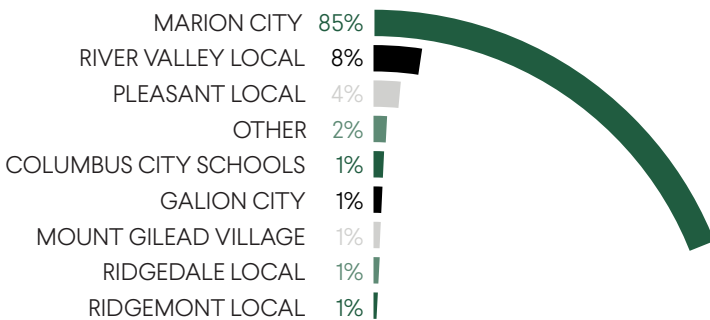
STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

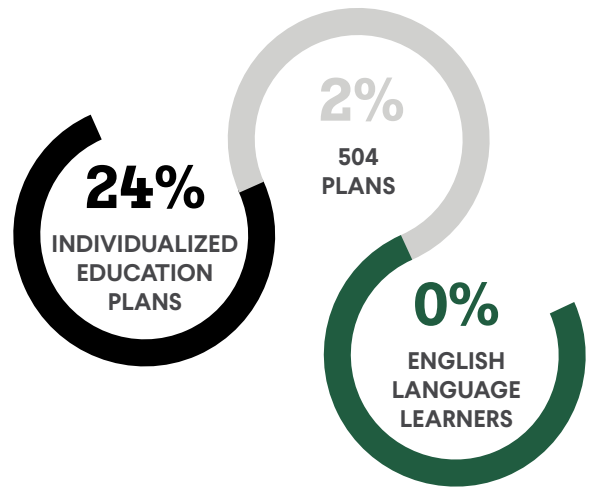
DISTRICTS OF RESIDENCE

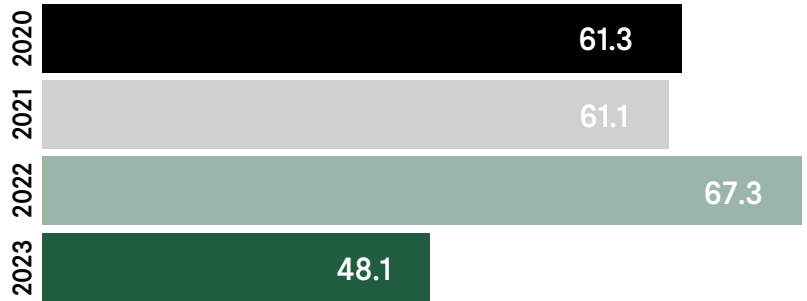

YOY PERFORMANCE INDEX SCORE



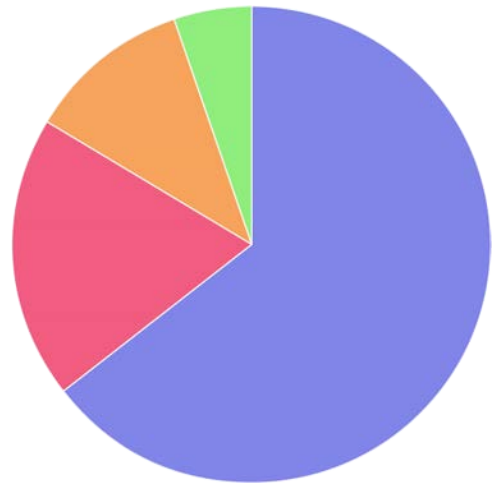
